CHAPTER 1

CHAPTER 3

Lesson Plan about Science




Objective	Food education
Setting	Classroom
Tools and materials	Video, handouts, pencils, poster
Introducing lesson 1 hour	After a great storm, Isabel found a big mess in the vegetable garden, all the vegetables labels are messed up. She asks help to the students: "You have to help me to place all the labels". The teacher gives the handouts to the students. (page 7)
First lesson 2 hours	The day after the party, Grace comes back home with a homework of Science. The teacher gives the handout with a dialogue between Grace and her mother. G: "Hello mum, how you doing? Can you help me with my homework, please?"

I: "Yes of course, what is that about?"
 G: "It's about the beneficial properties of fruit and vegetables"
 I: "Sure, show me the paper"
 Grace reads the article...
 G: "Fruit and vegetables are important for our health:

- the White food is important for our bones and heart;
- the Red food is important for our brain and heart;
- the Orange food is important for our sight and immunitary sistem;
- the Blue/ Purple food is important for our brain (memory) and immunitary sistem;
- the Green food is important for our bones, teeth and sight."

I: "Grace, fruit and vegetables are very colourful because they contain healthy substances like water, protein, lipids, mineral salts and vitamins"
 G: "So, we have to eat all those food everyday?"
 I: "We have to eat it five times a day. It is better for us and dad to have a balanced diet, so we have to eat vegetables and fruit with fish and meat, but it is better to eat white meat instead of the red one."
 G: "Thanks mum for your help!"

The teacher is reading, but sometimes she stops and helps the students to colour the parts of the body with the correct colour. Then, the teacher asks them: "Which white/ red/ orange/ blue-purple or green food can you think of?" Students answer. Then, the teacher shows a figure in which are represented different percentages of necessary substances for our body and students draw food for each colour. Finally, they write the names of the fruit the drawing.

	<p>I: “The Food Pyramid explain us how much and which kind of food we have to eat to keep us healthy”</p> <p>The students have to repeat the dialogue correctly before watching the video. After watching it, together they complete the poster (page 8) with the teacher.</p> <p>The billboard has this structure:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● In the middle there is this title: “AMONG THE FOOD THERE ARE”; ● From the middle 4 arrows with protein, fats, mineral salts and vitamins head in different directions; ● Under those names, students have to stick the correct pictures of food. <p>After that, the teacher gives to the students a handout with a blank Food Pyramid, they have to fill it with the correct food. This exercise will be useful for the next lesson. (page 9)</p>
<p>Third lesson 1 hour</p>	<p>The students have to write a letter to Peter, with this they want to invite him to follow a healthy diet.</p> <p>They have to follow the structure of the letter and use their previous knowledge.</p> <p>The teacher provides a model as example to follow: breakfast, lunch, dinner and breaks. (page 10)</p>
<p>Assessment 1 hour</p>	<p>The teacher gives Peter’s letter to the students, in which he answered at the previous letter they sent him, with some questions. (page 11)</p>

Lesson Plan about hours

Title of the lesson	Clock
Class	5°
Timing	4 lessons, 8 hours
Setting	Classroom, school gym
Tools and materials	Paper, scissors, glue, billboard, exercise book, handouts, flashcards, split pins.
First lesson	In the school gym the teacher creates two hands. 12 children are sitting on the floor in circle (they are the human numbers of the clock), the hands are in the middle. One child picks up a piece of the paper in which there is written the time (e.g. It's three o'clock). 2 children put the hands in the correct place to indicate the time.
Second lesson	The students have to build the clock with paper and a split pin.
Third lesson	The teacher gives flashcards, so, in groups, they can start to play memory. They have to match pictures with words. After this activity they have to complete one handout.
Fourth lesson	In the classrom we have a billboard in which there are written <ul style="list-style-type: none">● moments of the day● a clock that tells how to read the hours The teacher points one hours and one moment of the day and the children have to formulate a sentence. In the end, they are divided in couples, and they have to invent a dialogue with all moments of the day and the hours. After that, they write it on they exercise book.

HERE IS A SCRIPT FOR A THEATRICAL REPRESENTATION OF THE STORY.

"Steal at the Great Oak"

It's dark. A fox sneaks into the Squirrel family's kitchen.

He opens the fridge and steals the cake ingredients.

Light on the stage.

Peter opens the fridge to cook a cake.

Peter (shouting, clenching her fists): Isabel, come here immediatly!!! Something really, really bad happened here...

Isabel: Grace! George! Have you taken the berries?!

Grace and George enter in the kitchen frightened.

Grace (outraged): Mom! How you can think like bad?! George and I took some peaches as snacks this morning.

George (whispering): We knew that the berries in the fridge were necessary for the cake...

Everybody were thinking by it own.

Grace (excited, step one foot on the ground): I saw a fox running before we went to school!

Peter (angrily): THAT NASTY FOX IS BACK AGAIN!!!

Isabel: keep calm, I have an idea, we can go to our neighbors to ask for the ingredients!!

They go out of the stage.

The scene opens at the bat's home.

The Squirrel family are nervous and are knocking quickly at the door, calling out the bat.

The sleepy bat opens really slowly the door.

Bat: What is going on? How can I help you??

Isabel: The fox stole us the ingredients for our cake, do you have some blueberries?

Bat: Yes, I have. Here they are!

They go out of the stage.

The scene opens at the dormouse's home.

The Squirrel family are nervous and are knocking quickly at the door, calling out the dormouse.

The dormouse opens really slowly the door.

Dormouse: What is going on? How can I help you??

Isabel: The fox stole us the ingredients for our cake, do you have some blackberries?

Dormouse: Yes, I have. Here they are!

They go out of the stage.

The scene opens at the fawn's home.

The Squirrel family are nervous and are knocking quickly at the door, calling out the dormouse.

The fawn opens really slowly the door.

Fawn: What is going on? How can I help you??

Isabel: The fox stole us the ingredients for our cake, do you have some raspberries?

Fawn: Yes, I have. Here they are!

They go out of the stage.

The scene opens at the Squirrel's home.

While Grace and George are decorating the restaurants with some ornaments, Peter and Isabel are cooking the cake.

At 9 o'clock (a children holding a clock cross the stage) the guests knock at the door and they enter the stage.

Peter (happily): Come here Isabel! Our guests are finally here, there are the owl, the hedgehog, the bat with his friends of the "Bat Band", the dormouse and the fawn.

Everyone are now eating and dancing happily.

Peter notices the fox who was staring at the window,

so he decides to go out to speak with him.

Peter (upset): What are you doing here?

Fox (whisper): I heard the music, and I wish I could join the party

Peter (firmly): Yes, you can, but you have to clean up anything after the party!

Fox (quietly, with the tail between the legs): Yes I will, thank you... I promise I will steal nothing anymore.

In the final scene the Fox is cleaning the restaurant with the broom in his hand.

Peter sees and smiles.
