Subject and Object Pronouns



A subject pronoun is used in the subject of a sentence. Singular subject pronouns are ***I, you, he, she, and it.*** Plural subject pronouns are ***we, you, and they.*** When you use a person's name and a pronoun in a compound subject, be sure to use a subject pronoun. ***We invented an imaginary country. It is far away. Liz and I***



An object pronoun is used in the predicate of a sentence after an action verb or with a preposition. Singular object pronouns are ***me, you, him, her, and it.*** Plural object pronouns are ***us, you, and them.*** When you use a person's name and a pronoun in a compound object, be sure to use an object pronoun. ***That story reminds me of him. Leon told them. He helped Jenny and me.***
