4. **Writing version**





































5. Dogs only sweat from the bottoms of their feet, the only way they can discharge heat is by panting.
6. Rats can sense tension, fear and other negative emotions in the people who handle them and may respond in kind.
7. Contrary to popular belief, dogs aren't colour blind; they can see shades of blue, yellow, green and grey.
8. Domesticated for more than 10,000 years, the dog was one of the first animals domesticated by humans.
9. Cats do not sweat.
10. Some frogs smell of onion, and one type smells of garlic.
11. Cats have better memories than dogs. Tests conducted by the University of Michigan concluded that while a dog's memory lasts no more than 5 minutes, a cat's can last as long as 16 hours—exceeding even that of monkeys and orangutans.
12. Budgies can turn their heads 180 degrees. That gives them a great visual and helps them in their wild nature to avoid predators.
