


# Doing the shopping

<p><b><u>Questions</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can you recommend a good toy/clothes shop?</li> <li>• Is there a chemists/supermarket in the area?</li> <li>• Where can I get toothpaste/pet food?</li> <li>• Where's the nearest shopping centre?</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Answers/Comments</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There's a really good bookshop just around the corner.</li> <li>• The best toy shop is in the shopping centre.</li> <li>• The nearest one is a few miles away.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Questions</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What time do you open, please?</li> <li>• What time do you close, please?</li> <li>• What are your opening hours?</li> <li>• Are you open all day?</li> <li>• Are you open on Sundays?</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Answers/Comments</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We're open 24/7.</li> <li>• We're closed at lunchtime, between 12 and 2pm.</li> <li>• We're open from 9am till 6pm, Monday to Friday.</li> </ul>

<p><b><u>Questions</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Could you help me, please?</li> <li>• Could you tell me where the ..... department is?</li> <li>• Excuse me, I'm looking for a.....</li> <li>• Is there somewhere I can try this on, please?</li> <li>• Does it suit me?</li> <li>• Do you have this in a (larger/smaller size) (different colour), please?</li> <li>• Do you do alterations?</li> <li>• Do you have a refund policy?</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Answers/Comments</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It's too long / short / tight / loose.</li> <li>• The ladies / gents changing rooms are over there.</li> <li>• You can bring it back and exchange it or get a refund within 2 weeks if you keep the receipt.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Questions</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do you take credit cards?</li> <li>• Does it have a warranty?</li> <li>• Can I pay by cheque?</li> <li>• Do you offer a cash discount?</li> <li>• Could I leave my bags here and pick them up later?</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Answers/Comments</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We take all the major credit cards.</li> <li>• We only accept cheques with a cheque card.</li> <li>• Sorry, no.</li> <li>• Yes, certainly.</li> </ul>
